Notes of Committee Meeting – Thursday, 23 November 2023

Tim opened the meeting be conveying the Committee's regards to Philip on the sad loss of his wife.

1. Apologies for Absence

2. Matters Arising from Notes of meeting held 16 May:

- A configuration of light weight stakes and SI units has been tested and approved. Mike Elliot will now submit an order, hopefully in time for them to be used at the forthcoming Festive event. Total cost <£1,300.
- Tim Scarbrough yet to check neighbouring club websites are correctly listing our events.
- David Fisher and Tim working on thank you gift for Bill Alexander to be presented at the club dinner.

3. Fixtures

- The Fixtures List was circulated. Volunteers have largely been found but an organiser for the August Urban in Dorking is needed, and both planner and organiser are needed for the 2024 Festive Event (an alternative venue may also be required depending on whether we get access to Netley and how the first event goes).
- Netley: Tim has obtained email address of landowner but so far not received any response to emails sent. Mike E will call at landowner's house in next 2 weeks, if no response will leave copy of Tim's email. A back up plan was discussed with South Ashdown being the most likely. Mike E offered to plan if this back up was needed.
- British Middles (Spring 2025) now proposed to be same weekend as British Relays. Possibility that SO will
 organise relays and the option of using St Leonards for one day and Buchan/Holmbush for the other with a
 common parking area was discussed. MV would retain ownership of both maps.
- Park Race 2025 will be at Morden Hall Park possibly combined with (re)launch of POC.
- Festive Event 2023 Request from organiser for a 2 ring camping hob to heat up the mulled wine. John has one he can lend.
- Venue for league event 2026 Headley? Box Hill?
- The annual structure of our events was discussed in the light of us, ideally, wishing to move the Festive Event to earlier in December. However, this creates a clash with CHIG who traditionally use the earlier date. It was decided to continue largely with the existing structure.

4. Trophies

- Congratulations were extended to Leianne and Justin on their wins in the club championships.
- The winners of the George Murray Trophy (presented to the Mole with most points in the SE League) and the Peter Burt Trophy (presented to the most improved orienteer in the SE League not necessarily a Mole) are calculated by Philip. Who will action this shortly.
- The Junior Winner trophy at the club picnic is no longer presented but it could be resurrected should we have sufficient juniors in future.

5. **Bursar's Report**

• Justin reported that he has transferred some funds into a savings account in order to earn some interest.

• We have only received 1p from Amazon from the click through available on the website. Justin will check whether it is working correctly on the website with Dan Sullivan. Following which, Mike B will promote this to the rest of the membership to boost use and therefore funds.

Discussion as to whether this map should come offline in the meantime or whether those downloading the map should be warned of what is missing. No decision made.

- Buchan needs some replanning due to changes in land management 2025?
- A tree which has come down in Horton has completely obliterated one control.
