SEOA Score Championships

SUNDAY 31st October, 2010

- Venue:** Holmbush and Buchan Country Park
- Car Parking:** Enter by the main entrance to Holmbush House at GR TQ222342, which will be O signed in both directions along the A264 Crawley-Horsham Road (J11 M23).
This can only be accessed from the Westbound carriageway of the A264, 700 metres past the entrance to Holmbush Farm World. If approaching from the West, turn back at the Bewbush Manor roundabout approx 800m past Farm World on Eastbound c'way.
Parking is on a gently sloping grass field with an exit track along the foot of the slope – should be safe unless we have torrential downpours!
- Public Transport:** Buses run past the site – check with travelinesoutheast.org.uk :
200 from Horsham Station (Stop K) to Faygate Roundabout – 5minutes past the hour, 20 minute journey + 500 metre walk to the main entrance.
10 from Crawley Bus Station (Stand A) to Bewbush (Dorsten Sq), then 200 to Faygate Roundabout – 9:05, 10.05 & 10:55 , 25 minute journey including change of buses
- Map:** By Roger Maher 2008, updated by Mike Elliot Summer 2010. Scale: 1:10,000
- Registration:** 9:30 -12:00. Entry on the day only. **Note: Clocks go back the night before!**
- Starts:** Starts 10:00 - 12:30. Courses close 14:00
- Courses:** 60 & 40 minute Score courses for the SEOA championship.
Yellow Course for novices and young families.
- Score Champs:** Controls score 10, 15 or 20 points acc to technical difficulty and distance from start. There will be a penalty of 10 points for every minute or part minute late.
Only W/M16 and younger and W/M60 and older, count for the championships on the 40 minute score and their scores/penalties will be multiplied by 1.5. The choice of 40 or 60 minutes must be made at registration and cannot be changed later.
Each club gets the aggregate points of its top twelve individual scorers from different age classes. The scoring system automatically allows for running up – no declaration of teams is required. The club with the highest total score wins.
- Fees:** BO Seniors £5, non-BO members £7; Juniors £2. Parking Fee: £1 per car
The event will be using SportIdent electronic punching (hire charge £1).
- Officials:** Organiser – Mike Bolton; Planner – Simon Ling; Controller – Vince Joyce (SO)
- Facilities** Toilets, Squash + Holmbush Farm is open for (non-scary!) Halloween Tractor rides
- Dogs:** Welcome, on a lead
