**Registration:** Park Place (upstairs in the Toby Carvery). Entrance off Commonsides West at grid reference TQ281684. Mitcham Junction rail/tram stop 900m. Mitcham tram stop 800m. Mitcham Eastfields (train) 1km. Additional parking off Madeira Road

**Entry:** Entry on the day only. Seniors £3, MV/SLOW/LOK/DFOK members & locals £2, under 21 free. SI electronic punching will be used and dibbers are available from registration

**Map:** New extended map. Surveyed and drawn by Tony Burton 2013. Maps will be overprinted and waterproof

**Courses:** Short: 2-3km (no road crossings)  
Long: 4km (take care on road crossings)

**Starts:** 18.30 – 19.30. Outside Park Place. Courses close at 20.15

**Terrain:** Mix of grass and tarmac paths. Trainers and shorts can be worn
