SPRING EVENING EVENT at POLESDEN LACEY

Tuesday May 19th 2015

This is the second of a series of SUMMER EVENING events MVOC are organising on Tuesday nights from May to August and the very first opportunity to orienteer around this stunning location!

This event is designed to be both interesting and fun for newcomers to the sport and challenging for experienced orienteers

The Venue: Polesden Lacey contains one of Surrey's finest country houses with extensive grounds. The house itself is situated in an elevated position with views over Ranmore Common to the south and Great Bookham and beyond to the north. The event will visit pockets of ancient mature woodland linked by vast, open and undulating fields and pastures.

Format: There will be 2 linear courses of approx. 2.5km and 5km to provide a suitable challenge for all ages and abilities.

Map: This will be a brand new map at 1:5000 scale produced by Philip Gristwood to Sprint specification and printed on waterproof paper.

Registration location: Club tent or car on the perimeter of the main car park at Polesden Lacey which is at TQ 13605235. Polesden Lacey is signed with NT signs from the junction of the A246 (Leatherhead/Guildford Road) at TQ137544. After leaving A246, turn left after 100m into Polesden Lacey Road. After 1.3km turn right following NT signs and stay on this road to the car park.

Public Transport: Polesden Lacey is poorly served by public transport. The nearest rail stations are Westhumble approx 3km to the east, Bookham approx. 4km to the North. A limited bus service runs along the A246. A return service may not be viable.

Starts: from 6.30pm – 7.30pm

Entry Fee: £3 to non-BOF seniors; £2 to BOF seniors; £1 for all juniors under 18; free to MV members & supporters

Equipment: SI dibber (these can be loaned to those that don't have one); compass; whistle in case of injury; **full leg cover please** as there are nettles and brambles in places.

To enter: please email the planner at: **pgristwood@btinternet.com** to reserve a map. *Note:* BOF 3rd Party insurance does not cover any non-BOF member who has taken part on 3 or more BOF events. If you are affected, you are strongly advised to join a BOF club for your own peace of mind.
