SUMMER MID-WEEK EVENTS 2017 REIGATE URBAN

Tuesday 16th May 2017

This event should provide newcomers and experienced navigators with a fun and challenging evenings entertainment. It will also be an introduction to linear urban courses using a full colour detailed map for those that have only experienced our Winter Street O Score events. A linear course has no time limit but is one where you have to visit all the controls in numerical order.

The event: There will be 2 linear courses to choose from, both of which will be visiting the traffic free areas of The Castle grounds and Priory Park. Both courses also involve some street running so, to comply with BOF insurance rules, under 16's are welcome to take part but they must be accompanied by an adult.

SI controls will be used throughout. SI dibbers will be available to those that do not have one.

Courses (straight line distances):

Long course: 4.2km; 25 controls. (expect to run around 50% further)

Short course for newcomers and those wanting a short run: 2.7km; 18 controls (expect to run around 40% further)

Registration/ Start location: The Blue Anchor pub, 27 West Street, Reigate RH2 9BL. Map ref: TQ249503

Parking: Nearest car park is in Upper West Street. Free after 6.00pm

Public transport: Reigate rail station 600m. Numerous bus links to Reigate from all directions.

Map: Detailed 1: 4000 scale A3 size colour map drawn by Tom Murphy with some minor amendments by the organiser. Map *may* not be printed on waterproof paper in which case a bag will be supplied if it rains.

Equipment required: SI dibber (these can be loaned to those not having one); Compass not essential but could be useful in Priory Park or the Castle grounds. Full leg cover not essential but there are some small areas of unmown ground vegetation in Priory Park. **Hi-viz** top recommended for urban streets.

Entry Fee: £3 to all BOF members, £4 to non-BOF members. Free to Mole Valley OC members and Supporters. Newcomers may compete in pairs for the single fee providing only one map and dibber are used.

Entry system: Please email the organiser on **davidfisher99@virginmedia.com** to register your interest & reserve either a **Long** course map or a **Short** course map. Sorry, I cannot guarantee there will be a map available to those that do not reserve one.

Starts: Starts between 6.30pm and 8.00pm (no later please). **Note:** later starters should be aware the pub stops serving food at **8.30pm** if this required.

Safety: Unfortunately BOF public liability insurance does not cover non-members of British Orienteering Federation that have taken part in 3 BOF registered events.
