Horton Country Park, Epsom Sunday 3rd July 2022

Greater London Orienteering Summer Series
(GLOSS)

GLOSS courses of 4.3k with an optional extension of 2.7k, plus a yellow course of 2.4k will be offered

The event will be run in accordance with current British Orienteering (BO) & Government advice with regard to COVID-19

Entry System: All entries will be via racesignup.co.uk. Entries close at 18:00, 2nd July. There will be no entries on the day.

Entry Fees: £6 to all senior members, £2 to all juniors (under 16). Dibber hire £1. Helpers free.

Starts from 10.00 to 12.00. Course closes at 2.00

Horton Country Park has been newly mapped by Philip Gristwood. It comprises ancient woodlands, grassy meadows, fields, ponds and a well-established system of hard surfaced and grassy footpaths. Map scale is 1:10,000 with 5m contours using LiDAR data.

The Event Centre is in a field adjacent to the parking area.

Parking: Parking is within Horton Country Park, off Horton Lane, Epsom, Surrey, OS grid reference TQ 192616, Postcode is KT19 8PL, what3words ///fields.renew.sculpture. Please follow marshal's directions. Nearest rail stations are Epsom and Chessington South (2 km).

Public Transport: Epsom Station, served by both South Western Railway and Southern Railway, is a 2.3km walk away. The nearest bus stop is at the Old Moat Garden Centre, 300m away, but this is only served by the E10 bus.

Safety: Nearest A&E is 2 miles away at Epsom General Hospital, Dorking Rd, Epsom KT18 7EG, Tel. 01372 735735.

If lost head south to the edge of the park and follow the boundary road anti-clockwise to return to the carpark entrance. Full leg cover is mandatory as ticks are present.

Please respect out-of-bounds areas and do not go onto the neighbouring golf course, farm centre, equestrian centre or surrounding roads. The courses have been designed to be used without climbing any fences. The hay meadows have paths mown, please stick to them and do not trample the hay as it will be harvested in late July.

Dogs: Welcome if kept under control
