(GLOSS)

Mole Valley Orienteering Club welcomes you to Epsom & Walton Downs, which is home to the world famous Derby. On offer is a GLOSS (Light Green) course of 4.3k with an optional extension of 3k, plus a yellow course of 2.0k.

Entry System: Entries will be via racesignup.co.uk and close at 18:00, 8th July. There will be limited entry on the day subject to map availability and payment by card only.

Entry Fees: £6.00 before 4th July, £7.00 after 4th July (£8.00 for EOD) to all senior members, £2.00 before 4th July, £3.00 after 4th July (£4.0 for EOD) to all juniors (under 16). Dibber hire £1. Helpers free.

Starts from 10.00 to 12.00. Course closes at 14.00

Map and terrain: the map has been updated in Spring 2023. The area consists of wide-open grass areas with magnificent views over the racecourse and London. There are also pockets of woodland with intricate path networks which have been mapped in great detail. Full leg cover is strongly recommended.



The Event Centre Start, finish, and download/enquiries are all within 100 metres of the car park.

Parking: Free parking is at the public 7 furlong car park within the racecourse, which is accessed by the roundabout on the junction of Old London Road and Tattenham Corner Road what3words address `///arrow.hint.broken`.

Public Transport: Tattenham Corner is the nearest railway station (Southern Railway) and is less than 500 meters away. Epsom Station (South Western Railway and Southern Railway), is a 3.5km walk away. The nearest bus stop is 500m away and is served by the 460 & 480 busses from Epsom.

Safety: Nearest A&E is 4 miles away at Epsom General Hospital, Dorking Rd, Epsom KT18 7EG, Tel. 01372 735735.

Dogs: Welcome if kept under close control and must not be allowed near horses.
